Almost famous

Film review of the month

This charming film is about falling in love, young ambition, good mothers and — most of all — rock music. The director and writer is Cameron Crowe. Almost famous came out in 2001 but it is about the 1970s. The brilliant soundtrack is lots of rock music from that time.

The hero of the film is a 15-year-old school boy called William, played by Patrick Fugit. His mother (actress Frances McDormand) is a college professor. She has a strong idea of what she thinks is right and wrong. She cannot stand rock music, so she bans it from her house. William's sister Anita leaves home to become an air hostess, because their mother is so strict. When she goes, she tells William to look under her bed. There, she has a secret collection of rock music albums.

From this moment, William wants only one thing – to become a rock music critic. He gets the chance to write for Rolling Stone, a <u>legendary</u> music magazine. This is how he meets a new band called Stillwater. He also meets their number one fan, the lovely Penny Lane (Kate Hudson).

William goes on the tour bus across America with the musicians and their <u>roadies</u>. His story is about the power of music, friendship and <u>honesty</u>. *Almost famous* puts a smile on your face – watch it if you can!


